

Pesticide Notification

The New York Mills Union Free School District uses current Integrated Pest Management practices to reduce the use of pesticides in our buildings and on our grounds. It may be necessary, however, to use pesticides periodically during the year. New York State law requires that schools maintain a list of staff and parents who wish to receive a written notice forty-eight hours prior to a pesticide application at their school facility.
